

Dr Professor of Islamic Law **Kyriacos Th. Nicolaou-Patragas** studied in the Faculty of Law of Athens University and has Master degree in History of Law and PhD in the Greco-Roman and Islamic Law of the same faculty. His interests are directed towards Islamic Law and in general issues of Islam, Greco-Roman Law, the Justinian's Corpus Iuris Civilis, as well on the area of the Arab world and ideological directions in it.

He is the director of the Laboratory of Islamic Law and Arab-Islamic Studies of the University of Athens and also director and scientific manager of the Geopolitics Masters Degree of the Department of Turkish Studies in the same university. He is also teaching in the Military and Security Forces schools of Greece and he is a chair professor of Rifaat al-Said Islamic Studies in EPLO.

His authorship includes about 25 independent publications, 63 scientific articles, 4 translations, 12 works as an editor. He is also the Director of the magazine "Nomika Polyptiha" and co-director of the "Byzantina Diptiha" and responsible for the publications of the Islamic Law Laboratory, in which 20 volumes were published.
