**ΘΕΜΑ: Προγράμματα σπουδών-υποτροφίες στο Πανεπιστήμιο Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University (A.P.U.) της Ιαπωνίας για πτυχιακές και μεταπτυχιακές σπουδές για το ακαδημαϊκό έτος 2012-13.**

Το Υπουργείο Εξωτερικών (Ε1 Διεύθυνση Μορφωτικών και Πολιτιστικών Υποθέσεων) διαβίβασε στην υπηρεσία μας το υπ' αριθ. Α.Π.Φ. 4926.43/ΑΣ966/16/09/2011 έγγραφο της Πρεσβείας της Ελλάδας στο Τόκιο για την πραγματοποίηση προγραμμάτων σπουδών και την χορήγηση υποτροφιών πτυχιακού και μεταπτυχιακού επιπέδου στο Πανεπιστήμιο Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University (A.P.U.) της Ιαπωνίας για το ακαδημαϊκό έτος 2012-13.

Οι καταληκτικές προθεσμίες υποβολής αιτήσεων ποικίλουν αναλόγως του προγράμματος από 30.11.2011, 31.01.2012, 31.03.2012 και 10.05.2012.

Τα προγράμματα περιλαμβάνουν:

1. πτυχίο στις Κοινωνικές Επιστήμες (Πολιτιστική Διαχείριση, ΜΜΕ, Διεθνείς Σχέσεις και Ειρήνευση, Περιβάλλον και Ανάπτυξη, Σπουδές στον Τουρισμό) και
2. πτυχίο στη Διοίκηση Επιχειρήσεων.

Τα μεταπτυχιακά προγράμματα περιλαμβάνουν:

1. MSc και PhD στις Ασιατικές Σπουδές του Ειρηνικού, MSc στην Πολιτική Διεθνούς Συνεργασίας,
2. Μεταπτυχιακό στην Διεθνή Διαχείριση Ροής των Υλών, Διπλό Μεταπτυχιακό Πρόγραμμα και
3. Μεταπτυχιακό στη Διοίκηση Επιχειρήσεων (MBA).

Απαιτείται πολύ καλή γνώση της Αγγλικής ή της Ιαπωνικής γλώσσας, τα μαθήματα διδάσκονται είτε στη μία είτε στην άλλη γλώσσα.

Χορηγούνται υπό μορφήν υποτροφίας μειώσεις των διδάκτρων κατά 30%, 50%, 65%, 80% και 100% στους αιτούντες με ιδιαίτερα ακαδημαϊκά προσόντα, γλωσσική επάρκεια, όπως και ιδιαίτερα επιτεύγματα σε άλλους τομείς. 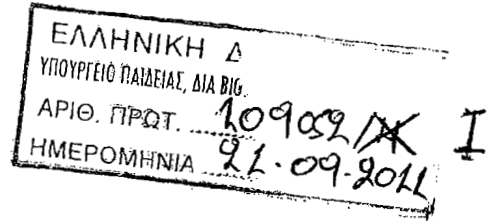

## Beppu City

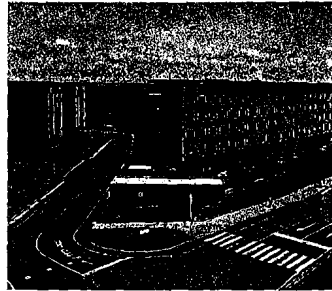

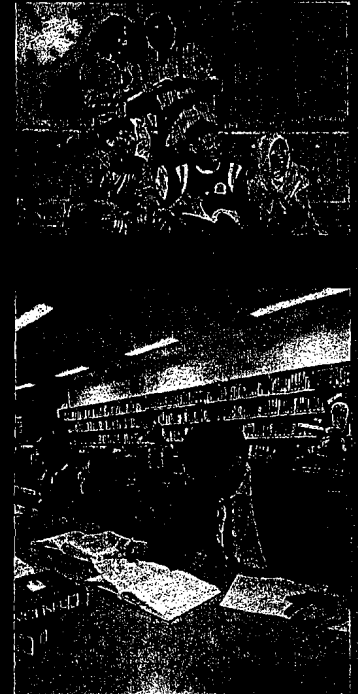

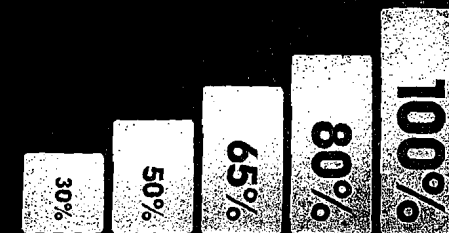

## Admission Requirements

**Undergraduate Programs:** Students can apply in English or Japanese. We require a minimum of 12 years or equivalent of a standard education and sufficient language ability in English or Japanese.

## Master's Program:

Applicants must have completed a regular Bachelor's degree from a recognized university with sufficient English language ability in order to carry out independent research.

## PhD Program:

Please contact the Admissions Office individually for advice on submitting a CV and research proposal for pre-screening.

- Admission Fee - 130,000 yen

### Dual Language Education

No Japanese language ability is required for admission to APU as almost all classes are offered in both English and Japanese. At the undergraduate level, students enter their chosen course on either an English or Japanese language basis and then given training in the alternative language if need be. As each student's language proficiency progresses, specialized classes can then be taken in either language. Within the Graduate School all classes are conducted entirely in English.
