- Creation of result-based lectures and teaching material for use in MA- and PhDlevel studies

## The following are to take place as part of the program:

- Workshops for the presentation of research findings and discussions on the translatability of these findings into teaching material for MA- and PhD-level studies
- Short-term visits and visiting lectures
   Greek scientists visits to the Global and European Studies Institute of the University of Leipzig, in combination with visiting lectures at the Centre for Area Studies and corresponding workshops for the development of a curriculum incorporating the three aforementioned project dimensions.
- 12th Summer School of the Graduate School of Global and Area Studies in Leipzig for PhD students of the partner universities aimed to promote the cooperation culture among the up-and-coming scientists and also support further training in the area of International Studies / New Regionalism
- Research visits by Greek up-and-coming scientists as part of the Leipzig Summer School
